
2024 Auction

Marielis Barreto

The Rev. Dr. Marielis Barreto has been pastoring at the Primera Iglesia Presbiteriana en Aguada (First Presbyterian Church in Aguada) since her ordination in 2000. The congregation stands out for its nearly 20-year community service thrift store ministry, Mission Bazaar. More recently, the congregation has been collaborating with Presbyterian Disaster Assistance to support

volunteer hurricane relief efforts through the Casita Ebenezer Volunteer Center.

Fast Facts About Puerto Rico

- Located in the heart of the Caribbean, Puerto Rico is an archipelago with two smaller, inhabited islands and several uninhabited islets.
- The Indigenous people of the island, the Taíno people, named the island Borikén. Thus, Puerto Ricans are also known as "Boricuas."
- Puerto Rico has a long history of being subjected to colonial rule beginning in 1493 when it was claimed by the Spanish Crown and extending to today, as it remains a colony of the U.S.
- Puerto Ricans are U.S. citizens who cannot vote in presidential elections.
- In 2017, more than 2,000 lives were lost in Hurricane Maria, and it was the worst storm to hit the island in more than eight decades.
- Puerto Ricans are largely religious. About half of the population identify as Roman Catholic, with another third identifying as Protestant.

Our Partners

- The Presbyterian churches in Puerto Rico are members of the PC(USA), organized in three presbyteries and one synod. Puerto Rican Presbyterians participate in the life of the church at large in committees, boards and as staff in the national offices.
- Presbyterian Disaster Assistance remains committed to our siblings in Puerto Rico. More than \$3.2 million in grants have gone to Puerto Rico to support the work of congregations and local organizations responding to the disasters, and over 2,000 PDA volunteers have worked on rebuilding projects since 2017.
